replace the ceiling with three trap doors so that any future occurrence of leaks can be easily reached.

Have you seen a Greek wedding dance?

There are at least three dancers. They start to go in circles, weaving in and out, in this wonderful moving pattern. They go faster and faster, all the while staying in perfect rhythm with each other until the whole dance becomes one beautiful motion. Even in this one dance, each person maintains their identity.

When we are thinking about the mystery of God as Trinity, this dance gives us a picture of how God is three in one. Father, Son & Holy Spirit are the same essence, in three forms. They are perfectly united in their own dynamic movement of life and love in, to and with one another.

Their dance overflows to all creation.

The Father gives His heart to us in Christ, and the Holy Spirit carries and ministers His love and gifts to us. He moves and acts in our heart, mind, and body to transform us to be like Him. When we 'dance' with the Trinity daily, in how we do relationship with God, we find that our actions and behaviour towards others exudes His life and love. We get to be part of God's invitation for them to dance!
